INTRODUCTION

ANALEMA is a film whose aesthetics, subject matter, and narrative differ greatly from the ordinary. The storyline of the film is circular, it can be watched from any point without affecting

its comprehension.

A couple, a man and a woman, who love each other deeply, reach a dead end in their turbulent relationship.

The role of the woman is played by five different actresses, which allows for a very wide range of interpretations: the complexity of the human personality, the infinite repetition of similar situations with different couples, subjectivity, timelessness, and even the possibility of parallel realities.

The camera is in continuous movement, creating the effect of perpetual motion of ideas and passions.

Almost empty spaces suggest the possibility of peeking into the most intimate world of this couple, witnessing their most secret and darkest desires.

Sensuality itself becomes another character expressed through captivating images of beautiful and diverse skin tones and textures, captured by the lens in a subtle and voluptuous way.

ANALEMA constructs a modern, audacious, and stark look at conflicts and challenges faced by couples today, exploring sexuality through intimate desires, feelings, longings, fears and fantasies, seeking to deconstruct myths, taboos, and anachronistic moralisms.

Watching ANALEMA is a visual, sensory, and emotional experience that will keep viewers on the edge of their seats as if it were a psychological thriller, while introducing humorous elements through a naturalistic narration which dilutes any hint of excessive drama.






LOGLINE



Rodolfo Graziano Cirillo, or Rodolfo Graziano, of Italo-Venezuelan origin, is an author and writer; producer and director of film, theater, and

television; multimedia artist and expert in media, advertising, and marketing. His academic background includes undergraduate, specialization, and postgraduate studies in journalism, photography, creative writing, and production and direction of radio, film, theater, television, and

multimedia; advertising and marketing, as well as cultural policies, visual arts, immersive experiences, and transmedia.

The interview book "AMOS DE LA NOCHE" was published by Editorial Planeta in

1994 and was recently reissued by Delivery Boy Media

Content. In 2023, he published his first novel "MI VIDA EN 30 NOMBRES."

He periodically published film criticism articles in various newspapers and specialized magazines such as EL NACIONAL, EL UNIVERSAL, EL DIARIO DE CARACAS, and REVISTA ENCUADRE, among the most important. His audiovisual productions (short films, video art, and medium-length films) have been distinguished with the OFFICIAL SELECTION of festivals such as: Hamburg International Film Festival 2010; Strasbourg International Film Festival 2008; Bogotá Film Festival 2008; Zinebi 49 International Film Festival (Bilbao) 2007; and with awards for Best Screenplay and Photography at the Mérida Film Festival 1985 for the short film "ALIRIO."

In 2012, he received the Lifetime Achievement Prize awarded by the FESTIDVQ Festival for his career as a filmmaker.

In 1992, he received the National Playwriting Award Aquiles Nazoa, Venezuela, for his play "ALGO OCURRIÓ CAMINO A IMPARARE."


"ANALEMA," his first feature film, was distinguished in 2023 with the Official Selection of the New York Independent Cinema Awards, San Diego Independent Cinema Awards, Venice International Independent Film Festival, London Director Awards, Tokyo International Cinema Awards, and won the following distinctions: Best Feature Film and Best Screenplay Feature at the Berlin Indie Film Festival, Gold Award Narrative Feature Drama at the Hollywood Independent Filmmaker Awards & Festival, Best Director (Rodolfo Graziano) at the San Diego Independent Cinema Awards, Best Actor (Armando Andrade), Best Cinematography (Jerónimo Goded), and Best Narrative Feature (Rodolfo Graziano) at the Art Film Spirit Awards. In 2024, it is part of the Official Selection of the Madrid International Film Festival. Meanwhile, "VAPOR," one of the five short films that make up "Tango Amor," was distinguished as the Official Selection of the Festival Mix Mexico, Cine y Diversidad Sexual.

In the performing arts, Rodolfo Graziano has been an artistic director and creator of multimedia installations (video design) for contemporary dance and opera shows. He has also produced and directed his own theatrical pieces, always employing audiovisual devices in which video art plays an important role.

As a multimedia artist, he has exhibited his work (multimedia installations, video art, photography, and sound installations) both individually and in collaboration with other artists in important galleries and museums in Venezuela, the United States, Colombia, England, and Spain.

His career as a television producer and director, at an international level, includes various entertainment programs made for channels in Latin America and the United States.

Currently, he directs the production company DELIVERY BOY MEDIA CONTENT in Mexico City, with which he advances projects in Film, Television, Theater, Immersive Experiences, and Multimedia Art.






CAST

Armando Andrade

Armando Andrade Vanegas was born in the State of Mexico. He began his artistic career in 2012 with the play El Pequeño Gran Club by Nickelodeon and Tycoon Gou, with which he participated in a national and international tour. In 2013, he participated in two theater productions: Oz the Musical, at Teatro Aldama, where he shared the stage with great musical theater personalities such as Natalia Sosa, Efrain Berry, and Valeria Vera, among others, and the successful Off Broadway play Con el Jesús en la Boca (Monkey Business).

The following year, he continued with Peter Pan, Un día en Nunca Jamás (Peter Pan, a Day in Neverland) with Daniela Luján, Hiromi, "El Borrego" Nava, and Lalo Manzano at the Blanquita Theater and in a national tour. He was also part of the cast of Dora la Exploradora (Dora The Explorer) as the character of Diego in the Asian tour. He participated in two seasons of Tenis by Argentine director Diego Besares during 2015 and 2016, and appeared for the first time on television on the Televisa program Como Dice el Dicho. He also acted in Telemundo's telenovela La Doña. In 2017, he visited eight countries on the international tour of Nickelodeon's Paw Patrol Latin America. At the end of the international tour, he began acting studies at Televisa's Centro de Educación Artística (CEA) where he graduated in 2019. While studying acting, he participated in Televisa's second season of the telenovela Por Amar Sin Ley. In the same year, he joined the cast of Alejandro Jodorowsky's play El Juego Que Todos Jugamos (The Game We All Play) with the endearing character of the Rabbit. After the 2021 pandemic, he resumed the season of Jodorowsky's classic and began recording the telenovela, SOS, Me Estoy Enamorando (SOS, I'm Falling in Love). In 2022, he continued with the projects: Contigo Sí and telenovela Mujer de Nadie on prime time, sharing the stage with maestro Enrique Singer and Verónica Merchant, produced by Televisa. Most recently, he performed in the premiere of the musical El Show de Terror de Rocky (The Rocky Horror Picture Show) in which he participated as an ensemble member and cover of Rocky.





Magaly Torres


Magaly Torres is a Mexican actress, dancer, model, and singer, born in the port of Veracruz. She studied acting with actor, director, and writer David Kaplan - one of the most important figures of theater in the world - who coined a new acting technique called "Five Approaches to Acting". She has also trained with teachers from Mexico, Italy, and New York, not only in acting for theater and film, but in various disciplines such as dance, singing, musical instruments, and sports, such as martial arts. She won the Águila De Fuego award for the film Ayer Hoy y Siempre (Yesterday Today and Always) at the Festival Internacional de Cine con Valor and a recognition for more than ten thousand copies sold in less than a month for the film Laina. She began her career at the age of 14, dabbling in professional dance, and soon after in television. In 2009, she started in the film industry with the movie Sombra (Shadow), after which she debuted as a leading actress in the film Laina by Mexican director Carlos Reyes. Countless projects have followed since then in theater, musical theater, television, and film. She is currently a model for a well-known clothing brand and making the most out of her acting career. In 2023 she will premiere in a soap opera for Televisa, a series with Sony Channel, and take on another leading role in a movie.





Miriam Rascol

Miriam Rascol is a Mexican actress and broadcaster. She is in consistent training and acting lab with her coach Monica Portillo. She has a comic vision and performs in melodrama and in more naturalistic styles. She studied acting at the JC Actors school in Madrid. In Mexico she has completed her training with the Meisner technique at Casa Azul and specialized in cinema at La Cuarta Pared. Her last TV project was Si Nos Dejan, and she has also participated in other TV series, such as Preso No.1, Señora Acero, El Señor de los Cielos and La Impostora. In film, her projects include Inicuo: La Hermandad, a suspense feature film that was in the main horror festivals in the world, and the comedy Chat Familiar. In theater in 2022, her projects have been La Casa de Bernarda Alba at the Ex Convento de San Hipólito and Alicia y las Maravillas del Borderline at the Teatro Centrado Coyoacán. She has also participated in the significant play El Hombre Triste at the Foro Shakespeare. She was in charge of the RMX music network at Grupo Imagen as an announcer and host.






Yolloti Manzur



Andrea Barbier



Rocio Vazquez



In her last years of study, Angelika participated in several beauty pageants, and from there she worked in modeling. After graduating when she was 21 years old, she traveled the world as a model. She has lived in Thailand, Hong Kong, China, France, Germany, and Peru. In Mexico, she resumed her passion for acting and dance, theater, cinema, and Spanish language while developing her dancing skills.






Alphonso Escobedo

Alphonso Escobedo was born in Mexico City and debuted at age 5 doing commercials and performed in Christian plays in church as an adolescent. In the Mexican state of Tepotzotlán, he began a modeling and a classical opera course with the Oaxacan tenor Luis Adrián (winner of the Voice of Mexico). Alternating boxing with acting classes at the age of 15, he began his training in dramatic art with the teacher Margarita Mandoki with whom he studied for 2 years and experimented with the Adler technique. His first television appearance was at the age of 17 in La Rosa de Guadalupe. He has made more than 30 television appearances in his career: 25 episodes of Como Dice el Dicho, and several appearances in more than 9 years on Televisa.

In film, he debuted with the character "Blondy" in La Diosa del Asfalto by Julián Hernández, which premiered at the Morelia Film Festival in 2020. He also participated in La Danza de Las Fieras and many other short films including Tespis (a short film tribute to teacher Ernesto Gómez Cruz) directed by Alejandro Ramírez and produced and written by Alberto Estrella, and had a co-starring role in Blu Short Film by Orlando Rosillo. He has participated in theater since the age of 17 with many different companies in various states of the country. In 2019, he participated in the penultimate season of Por María at the no longer active Microteatro in Mexico City, in which the staging achieved 5 Stars.





Natali Conzález

Natali González graduated from INBA in 2011 with a degree in Contemporary Dance. In 2013, she received an Honorable Mention in the 15th "Hector Chavez" Culiacan Choreography Contest. She participated in the course and assembly of the repertoire of the José Limón Company as well as in the intensive Butoh workshop with master Espartaco Martínez. She attended the workshop Dancing in Public Space within the Encuentro Internacional de Escena Contemporánea, and Transversales with the French company Ex Nihilo, directed by Anne Le Batard and Jean-Antoine Bigot. She was a guest speaker at the 2012 Research and Experimentation in Choreographic Creation Cycle: The Value of the Creative Process for Emerging and Established Creators by Gabriela Medina. She collaborated in the image of the Ciclo Internacional de Danza en Países Urbanos in 2006 and in the Canal 22 spot for the TV program Opera Prima @elcolectivo. She was the Creative interpreter of Video Danza Anatomy of Melancholy by Nuria Fragoso, and was the Dance Movies EMPAC 2010 Fellow. She has collaborated with prominent artists, scenic and Mexican dance groups and has been a fellow of the Community Arts and Crafts Workshops Program (2019-2020-2021). She is also a dancer of the 6th cast of the Centro de Producción de Danza Contemporánea (2022-2023).

Ulises Conzález

Ulises González was born in San Nicolás de los Garza Nuevo Leon, México. He is a regional performance artist, and graduated in contemporary dance from the Escuela Superior de Música y Danza de Monterrey del INBAL. He was a member of the companies Cuerpo Etéreo (2001-2007), A Poc A Poc (2008-2011) and was part of the first, second and third cast of dancers of CEPRODAC IBA/FONCA, (2011-2017). He has participated as a guest artist in outstanding national groups. Internationally, he has shown his work in Germany, Ecuador, France, United States, Colombia, Portugal, Algeria, Tunisia, and Costa Rica. In 2005, he won the Recognition for Best Male Performer within the Binational Choreography Award of the Extremadura International Dance Festival, and in 2013 achieved second place in the First International Dance Competition for Solo Dancer in the Lila López International Contemporary Dance Festival. In 2017, he was a member of the International Jury of the XXXIV Festival of Choreographers Graciela Moreno of Costa Rica. As a choreographer, he was a finalist on three occasions for the International Dance Award of the Extremadura Festival and has created pieces for a wide variety of ensembles.





Jerónimo Coded - Director of Photography

Jerónimo Goded studied at the Escuela Activa de Fotografía where he focused mainly on

exhibitions and personal projects. Subsequently, he entered the world of film and television, achieving the award for best cinematography with the short film Violet Prevails at the

Berlin International Art Film Festival.



Born in Mexico City, Galia Eibenschutz is a choreographer, visual artist, dancer, and performer. She studied visual arts at the Escuela Nacional de Artes Plásticas and has a master's degree in theater and dance at DasArts in Amsterdam, Holland. She specialized in classical ballet, contemporary dance (Limon technique, Gaga, Topf), Kung Fu, Qi Gong, voice, and African dance studies. Her performance work has been presented at the Teatro de la Danza, Museo Tamayo, Museo Jumex, Museo Carrillo Gil, Centro Cultural de España in Mexico City, Hospicio Cabañas in Guadalajara, the Centro Nacional de las Artes in San Luis Potosí, The Cedar Cultural Center in Minneapolis, Minnesota, and the Center for Arts and Communication in Miami. Her work has been exhibited in Toronto, Paris, Mexico City, New York, Tokyo, Belgium, and Colombia. She has participated in national and international contemporary dance festivals such as PERFORMA in New York City, Encuentro Nacional de Danza in Mexico City, Camp in, Onésimo González, and Ochótic. She was selected as choreographer of 2019 by the Mcknight Foundation in Minneapolis. In 2016, her Drawing and Movement Lab project was selected by CEPRODAC-INBA. In 2012, she was a beneficiary of the National Dance Stimulus Program EPRODANZA-CND/INB, Mexico. She has received support from the Patronato de Arte Contemporáneo in 2021, and from the Fundación Jumex in 2022, 2011, and 2005. She has also received scholarships from Jóvenes Creadores/ FONCA (1999-2000) and from the Sistema Nacional de Creadores del Arte FONCA (2013-2016) (2017-2020).
